



Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft – German Research Foundation

Self-governing organisation for science and research

yearly budget: 2.8 billion Euro,

provided by the Federal Government (67%) and the states (33%)

Mission

- to fund best research projects
- to advance early career researchers
- to support interdisciplinary and international cooperation
- to give policy advice

Helmholtz-Association of German Research Centres

Largest scientific organization in Germany yearly budget: 4,5 billion Euro 18 research centres

Mission

- to solve grand challenges which face society, science and industry in the fields of

- Aeronautics, Space and Transport

- Energy
- Health
- Matter, and
- Key Technologies
- to research highly complex systems using large-scale scientific infrastructure in close cooperation with national and international partners.



Max Planck Society

yearly buget: 1.8 billion EUR 83 research institutes

- to build up research institutes solely around the world's leading researchers
- to conduct basic research in the natural sciences, life sciences, social sciences, and the humanities
- to foster creative potential of young researchers
- to operate a worldwide network based on cooperation



Leibniz-Association

yearly budget: 1.7 billion Euro 91 research institutes

<u>Mission</u>

- to address issues of social, economic and ecological relevance focusing on natural, engineering and environmental sciences as well as economics, spatial and social sciences and humanities
- to conduct knowledge-driven and applied basic research
- to maintain scientific infrastructure
- to provide research-based services



yearly budget: 440 million Euro

the world's largest funding organisation for the international exchange of students and researchers

- Scholarships for the best
- Structures for internationalisation
- Expertise for academic collaboration



yearly budget: 118 million Euro

- sponsorship of international academics
- strengthening cutting-edge research through internationalization
- impetus for the research location Germany by promoting individuals
- advancing development through academic cooperation



yearly budget: 150 million Euro

!!! Important to know and to follow !!!

In general:

- <u>High competition</u> for funds
- Only the <u>best ideas</u> will be successful
- <u>Excellence</u> in research is required
 - i.e. good performance in <u>publications in international</u> <u>reviewed journals</u> with a high impact factor
 - prove of successful managed projects

!!! Important to know and to follow !!!

In general:

- in most cases you need a German partner, who must be interested in your project and who is convinced that you are a good partner to be successful when applying for funds
- in most cases the German organisation asks for joint financing, i.e. you have to cover some of the costs of the project





Agreement on scientific cooperation since 2010

Grants to initiate and intensify bilateral cooperations

bilateral seminars

(should lead to the preparation of a joint research project) one week, up to 10 scientists from each side

preparatory visits

(to develop cooperate activities) up to 3 weeks, one scientist

consultative visit

(doing complementary research in their own countries up to three months, one scientist 17.0

- Normally for three years

 - consumables
 - travel



How to search for funding opportunities

- 1. Do not start searching for funds before you exactly know
 - what is your research question ?
 - what do you need to perform the project?
 - How long will it take to perform the project?
 - At which place you will do the research?
- 2. Write down the essentials of your project !
- 3. Discuss it with some colleagues and ask for their opinion !
- Start searching by using searchmasks or ask a good colleague in Germany, if you intend to apply to a German funding agency.
- 5. Be very serious about the guidelines of the funding agency !
- 6. Be very serious about your own standing in research !
